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WAPA Announces Adjusted Business Office Hours for July 28 and July 29

U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS (July 24, 2026) – The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority (“WAPA” or “the Authority”) advises the public that business office hours will be adjusted on **Tuesday, July 28, and Wednesday, July 29**, to allow employees to participate in a scheduled all-employee meeting.

The adjusted hours are as follows:

Tuesday, July 28

- St. Croix – Sunny Isles Business Office: 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Wednesday, July 29

- St. Thomas – Port of Sale Business Office: 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- St. John – Market Place Business Office: Closed

- Bank branches: Make payments at First Bank, Banco Popular, and Bank of St. Croix.
- Kiosk: Use the self-service payment kiosk located outside our business offices.

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About WAPA: The Virgin Islands Water and Power Authority is an autonomous agency of the Virgin Islands Government which produces and distributes electricity and drinking water to residential and commercial customers in the territory. WAPA was created by the Fifth Legislature of the Virgin Islands in 1964 through Act No. 1248. Today, WAPA generates electrical power at production plants on St. Thomas and St. Croix and distributes electrical service through smart grids to customers on St. Thomas, St. Croix, St. John, Hassel Island, and Water Island. Potable water is distributed to almost 13,000 customers through water lines and standpipes. WAPA also has the responsibility of installing and maintaining streetlights.
